25. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of a Speed/Speed Junior Licence is required for this Event. ALL LICENCES MUST BE CURRENT. THE CLUB TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RENEWAL OR PURCHASE OF THE COMPETITOR'S LICENCE. Competitors must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club and produce a current valid Membership Card.

26. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:

- All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn by all competitors.
- Safety webbing/wrist restraints are to be fitted to all Motorkhana specials and open wheel vehicles in a manner that will prevent Competitors arms from protruding from the vehicle in the event of an accident.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Drivers of vehicles to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Logbooks as issued by Motorsport Australia must be presented at Scrutineering for each Event.
- The Scrutineer will be the judge of fact in all matters relevant to vehicle eligibility and presentation.

27. CLASSES:

It is at the club Organiser's discretion to re-classify any vehicle if they believe it is not eligible for the class they are entered in.

28. RESULTS:

Results will be determined from the lowest combined total time of the tests completed, plus any penalties. All competitors must complete all tests to be classed as a finisher.

29. PRIZES & TROPHIES:

1ST, 2ND, 3RD OUTRIGHT / 1ST in Class – All Classes / 1ST LADY / 1ST, 2ND, 3RD JUNIOR.

It is at the club Organiser's discretion to re-classify any vehicle if there are 3 or less competitors in that class.

30. The Motorsport Australia Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

31. The Organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR.

32. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

33. PENALTIES

| | Penalty Condition | Penalty Applied |

| (i) | Knocking any Maker | Plus five seconds each infringement |
| (ii) | Vehicle not fully garaged during the course of a test | Plus five seconds each infringement |
| (iii) | Finishing a test with part of the vehicle completely outside the end of the finish garage | Plus five seconds |
| (iv) | Failing to halt completely at the finish off the test | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (v) | Finishing a test with the vehicle completely outside the finish garage boundaries | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (vi) | Incorrect method (any procedure other than the correct procedure for completing that test) | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (vii) | Failure to complete a test | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (viii) | Running out of order without the prior approval of the Clerk of Course | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (ix) | Reversing after crossing the designated finish line | Slowest time plus five seconds |
| (x) | Failure to attempt a test | Slowest time plus ten seconds |

34. JUNIORS

The minimum driver age is 12 as per the Motorsport Australia Motorkhana Standing Regulations. Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter-signed /consented to by Parent/Guardian.

35. The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

36. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

38. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1ST

This event will be conducted in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Occupational Health and Safety Policy, which is available to be viewed at www.motorsport.org.au. Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the working conditions of their associated personal at all times and must ensure that all applicable safe working conditions are met.

39. PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event will NOT include Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA).

41. CAMPING

All Competitors/drivers are responsible for the behaviour/conduct of the occupants of the camp site. They must be listed on the Campers Disclaimer Form which will be available on the website and available in the Clubhouse on the information table inside the main door. Camping & Hot showers are available to you the members free of charge so please keep them clean and do the right thing and put it in a bin. The noise curfew is 10pm, please be mindful of others.

42. Integrity, Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

Smoking

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.
