**25. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS**  
A minimum of a Speed of Speed Junior Licence is required for this event. ALL LICENCES MUST BE CURRENT.  
THE CLUB TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RENEWAL OR PURCHASE OF THE COMPETITOR'S LICENCE.

**26. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Competitors must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club and produce a current valid Membership Card.
- Central North Coast Sporting Car Club has elected to run their Khanacross events as per Group 4K Khanacross code and schedule A of the Motorsport Australia manual. Unless specified in these regulations ALL VEHICLES must comply with Schedule A and Group 4K Khanacross code of the Motorsport Australia
- A fire extinguisher of at least 900g capacity, complying with Schedule H of the Motorsport Australia Manual (refer "General Requirements for Cars and Drivers") must be fitted.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 2wd Specials will include "Purpose Built Specials" as defined under Group 4K Regulations in the Auto Test section of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 4wd vehicles must comply with 'Production Cars" or MP class as specified in Group 4K Auto Test section of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Logbooks as issued by Motorsport Australia must be presented at Scrutineering for each Event.
- The Scrutineer will be the judge of fact in all matters relevant to vehicle eligibility and presentation.
- Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn by all competitors.

**28. RESULTS:**

Results will be determined from the lowest combined total time of the tests completed, plus any penalties. All competitors must complete all tests to be classed as a finisher.

**29. PRIZES & TROPHIES:**

1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup> OUTRIGHT / 1<sup>st</sup> in Class – All Classes / 1<sup>ST</sup> LADY / 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNIOR. It is at the club organiser's discretion to re-classify any vehicle if there are 3 or less competitors in that class.

**30.** The Motorsport Australia Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

**31.** The Organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

**32.** Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

**33. PENALTIES**

<b>(i)</b>	Wrong direction	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(ii)</b>	Any other action that can be deemed as incorrectly completing that course (such as reversing after exceed the limits of the garage)	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(iii)</b>	Failure to complete a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(iv)</b>	Running out of order without the prior approval of the Clerk of Course	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(v)</b>	Failing to stop completely within a midcourse garage	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(vi)</b>	Failing to stop completely at the finish of a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(vii)</b>	Finish a test with the car stopped but completely outside the garage	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(viii)</b>	Finish a test with part of the car outside the garage boundaries (plus the penalty for striking and flag/marker)	Plus five seconds plus any flag/marker strike

<b>(ix)</b>	Striking a course flag/marker (including garage boundary flag/marker)	Plus five seconds per flag/marker
<b>(x)</b>	Failure to attempt a test	Slowest time plus ten seconds

**34. JUNIORS**

The minimum driver age is 12 as per the Motorsport Australia Standing Regulations. Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter-signed /consented to by Parent/Guardian.

**35. INSURANCE**

**36.** The Organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the Event without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

**37.** Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the current NCR.

**38. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1<sup>ST</sup>**

This event will NOT include Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA).

**41. CAMPING**

All Competitors/drivers are responsible for the behaviour/conduct of the occupants of the camp site. They must be listed on the Campers Disclaimer Form which will be available on the website and available in the Clubhouse on the information table inside the main door. Camping & Hot showers are available to you the members free of charge so please keep them clean and do the right thing and put it in a bin. The noise curfew is 11pm, please be mindful of others.

**42. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

**43. ANIMALS/PETS**

NO ANIMALS/PETS allowed on club grounds unless registered under the Companion Animals Act 1998 (Documentation for these Animals must be provided).

**44. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or lack of sense of smell.
