**25. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS**

A minimum of a Speed/Junior Licence is required for this event. ALL LICENCES MUST BE CURRENT. THE CLUB TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RENEWAL OR PURCHASE OF THE COMPETITOR'S LICENCE. Competitors must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club and produce a current valid Membership Card.

**26. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:**

- All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn by all competitors.
- Safety webbing/wrist restraints are to be fitted to all Motorkhana specials and open wheel vehicles in a manner that will prevent Competitors arms from protruding from the vehicle in the event of an accident.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Drivers of vehicles to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Logbooks as issued by Motorsport Australia must be presented at Scrutineering for each Event.
- The Scrutineer will be the judge of fact in all matters relevant to vehicle eligibility and presentation.

**27. CLASSES:**

A	2WD, Wheelbase up to 2150mm
B	2WD, Wheelbase 2151mm to 2390mm
C	2WD, Wheelbase 2391mm to 2574mm
D	2WD, Wheelbase 2575mm and over
E	All 4WD Vehicles
F	Front – Wheel Drive Specials
G	Rear – Wheel Drive Specials

It is at the club organiser's discretion to re-classify any vehicle if they believe it is not eligible for the class they are entered in.

**28. RESULTS:**

Results will be determined from the lowest combined total time of the tests completed, plus any penalties. All competitors must complete all tests to be classed as a finisher.

**29. PRIZES & TROPHIES:**

1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup> OUTFIGHT / 1<sup>st</sup> in Class – All Classes / 1<sup>ST</sup> LADY / 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNIOR.

It is at the club organiser’s discretion to re-classify any vehicle if there are 3 or less competitors in that class.

**30.** The Motorsport Australia Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

**31.** The Organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

**32.** Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

**33. PENALTIES**

<b>(ii)</b>	Vehicle not fully garaged during the course of a test	Plus five seconds each infringement
<b>(iii)</b>	Finishing a test with part of the vehicle completely outside the end of the finish garage	Plus five seconds
<b>(iv)</b>	Failing to halt completely at the finish off the test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(v)</b>	Finishing a test with the vehicle completely outside the finish garage boundaries	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(vi)</b>	Incorrect method (any procedure other than the correct procedure for completing that test)	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(vii)</b>	Failure to complete a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(viii)</b>	Running out of order without the prior approval of the Clerk of Course	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(ix)</b>	Reversing after crossing the designated finish line	Slowest time plus five seconds
<b>(x)</b>	Failure to attempt a test	Slowest time plus ten seconds

**34. JUNIORS**

The minimum driver age is 12 as per the Motorsport Australia Standing Regulations.

Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter-signed /consented to by Parent/Guardian.

**35.** The Organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the Event without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

**36.** Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the current NCR.

**38. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1<sup>ST</sup>**

This meeting will be conducted in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Occupational Health and Safety Policy, which is available to be viewed at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au). Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the working conditions of their associated personal at all times and must ensure that all applicable safe working conditions are met.

Any The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

**43. ANIMALS/PETS**

NO ANIMALS/PETS allowed on club grounds unless registered under the Companion Animals Act 1998 (Documentation for these Animals must be provided).

**44. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event.

This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or lack of sense of smell.
