- 4wd vehicles must comply with ‘Production Cars” or MP class as specified in Group 4K Khanacross Standing Regulations.
- Logbooks as issued by Motorsport Australia must be presented at Scrutineering.
- The Scrutineer will be the Judge of Fact in all matters relevant to vehicle eligibility.
- Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn by all competitors

### 31. PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event will NOT include Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA).  
Instructors must have a Motorsport Australia Official’s coach licence.

### 32. SELF-EXTRACTION

Competitors must be able to exit their vehicle within 10 seconds in 2025. The Motorsport Australia Self Extraction Policy can be found at [motorsport.org.au](http://motorsport.org.au)  
Self-Extraction testing may be carried out at this Event.

### 33. PENALTIES

	<i>Penalty Condition</i>	<i>Penalty Applied</i>
<i>I.</i>	Wrong direction	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>II.</i>	Any other action that can be deemed as incorrectly completing that course (such as reversing after exceed the limits of the garage)	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>III.</i>	Failure to complete a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>IV.</i>	Running out of order without the prior approval of the Clerk of Course	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>V.</i>	Failing to stop completely within a midcourse garage	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VI.</i>	Failing to stop completely at the finish of a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VII.</i>	Finish a test with the car stopped but completely outside the garage	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VIII.</i>	Finish a test with part of the car outside the garage boundaries (plus the penalty for striking and flag/marker)	Plus five seconds plus any flag/marker strike
<i>IX.</i>	Striking a course flag/marker (including garage boundary flag/marker)	Plus five seconds per flag/markers
<i>X.</i>	Failure to attempt a test	Slowest time plus ten seconds

- 35. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1<sup>ST</sup>**  
Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the working conditions of their associated personal at all times and must ensure that all applicable safe working conditions are met.
- 36. INTEGRITY**  
Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).  
Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.  
Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
- 37. SMOKING**  
Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.
- 38. RESULTS**  
Results will be determined from the lowest combined total time of the tests completed, plus any penalties. All competitors must complete all tests to be classed as a finisher.
- 39. PRIZES & TROPHIES**  
1ST, 2ND, 3RD OUTRIGHT, LADY & JUNIOR / 1st in Class – All Classes
- 40. CNCSCC CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**  
Competitor must be a current financial member of the Central North Coast Sporting Car Club to receive points in the CNCSCC Club Championship.
- 41. CANTEEN**  
Will be open from 7.30am for Breakfast, Canteen will stop cooking at approx. 2pm
- 42. CAMPING**
