SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

18. ENTRIES

Entries may be made online via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry System. Alternatively, paper entry form may be downloaded from our website and emailed to CncsccEventSec@Gmail.com along with Motorsport Australia General Disclaimer forms. The Event Secretary may be contacted on 0476 909 383.

19. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

20. The Organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with the NCR.

21. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of a Speed or Speed Junior Licence is required for this Event.

* ALL LICENCES MUST BE CURRENT *

The Organisers take no responsibility for the renewal or purchase of the Competitors Licence.

22. JUNIORS

Minimum driver age is 12 as per the Motorsport Australia Motorkhana Standing Regulations. Entries from Competitors aged under 18 must be signed/consented to by Parent/Guardian.

23. The Motorsport Australia Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

24. DOCUMENTATION

TIME: 10:30am – 11:30am

VENUE: Veranda outside Club House

25. SCRUTINY

There will be no in-person scrutiny at the Event. Competitors will be required to Self-Scrutinise their competition vehicles, apparel and safety devices and complete the Self-Scrutiny Checklist. These forms will be available on our website and must be emailed to the Event Secretary at CncsccEventSec@Gmail.com.

SCRUTINY SPOT CHECKS will be carried out throughout the Event to check compliance.

26. DRIVERS BRIEFING

VENUE: Veranda outside Club House

It is compulsory for ALL drivers to attend.

28. The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR, or if less than 10 entries are received by close of entries.

29. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn by all competitors.
- Safety webbing/wrist restraints are to be fitted to all Motorkhana specials and open wheel vehicles in a manner that will prevent Competitors arms from protruding from the vehicle in the event of an accident.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Drivers of vehicles to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

- Logbooks as issued by Motorsport Australia must be presented at Scrutineering for each Event.
- The Scrutineer will be the Judge of Fact in all matters relevant to vehicle eligibility and presentation.

30. CLASSES

A	2WD, Wheelbase up to 2150mm
B	2WD, Wheelbase 2151mm to 2390mm
C	2WD, Wheelbase 2391mm to 2574mm
D	2WD, Wheelbase 2575mm and over
E	All 4WD Vehicles
F	Front – Wheel Drive Specials
G	Rear – Wheel Drive Specials

It is at the Organisers discretion to re-classify any vehicle if they believe it is not eligible for the class they are entered in, or if there are 3 or less competitors in that class.

31. PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event will NOT include Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA).
Instructors must have a Motorsport Australia Official's coach licence.

32. PENALTIES

	<i>Penalty Condition</i>	<i>Penalty Applied</i>
<i>I.</i>	Knocking any Marker	Plus five seconds each infringement
<i>II.</i>	Vehicle not fully garaged during the course of a test	Plus five seconds each infringement
<i>III.</i>	Finishing a test with part of the vehicle completely outside the end of the finish garage	Plus five seconds
<i>IV.</i>	Failing to halt completely at the finish off the test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>V.</i>	Finishing a test with the vehicle completely outside the finish garage boundaries	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VI.</i>	Incorrect method (any procedure other than the correct procedure for completing that test)	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VII.</i>	Failure to complete a test	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>VIII.</i>	Running out of order without the prior approval of the Clerk of Course	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>IX.</i>	Reversing after crossing the designated finish line	Slowest time plus five seconds
<i>X.</i>	Failure to attempt a test	Slowest time plus ten seconds

33. SELF-EXTRACTION

Competitors must be able to exit their vehicle within 10 seconds in 2025. The Motorsport Australia Self Extraction Policy can be found at motorsport.org.au
Self-Extraction testing may be carried out at this Event.

34. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

- 35. SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS – SAFETY 1ST**
Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the working conditions of their associated personal at all times and must ensure that all applicable safe working conditions are met.
- 36. INTEGRITY**
Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.
Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
- 37. SMOKING**
Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.
- 38. RESULTS**
Results will be determined from the lowest combined total time of the tests completed, plus any penalties. All competitors must complete all tests to be classed as a finisher.
- 39. PRIZES & TROPHIES**
1ST, 2ND, 3RD OUTRIGHT, LADY & JUNIOR / 1st in Class – All Classes
- 40. CNCSCC CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**
Competitor must be a current financial member of the Central North Coast Sporting Car Club to receive points in the CNCSCC Club Championship.
- 41. CANTEEN**
Will be open from 10.30am, Canteen will stop cooking at approx. 2pm
- 42. CAMPING**
All Competitors/drivers are responsible for the behaviour/conduct of the occupants of the camp site. They must be listed on the Campers Disclaimer Form which will be available on the website and available in the Clubhouse on the information table inside the main door.
