It does not constitute a check or confirmation that the vehicle complies with the relevant Motorsport Australia NCR or Event Regulations. It does not constitute a check of roadworthiness requirements under the relevant State legislation and neither Motorsport Australia, nor its officials, officers or agents make any undertaking as to whether this vehicle is eligible under law to travel on public roads.*

All items presented in this document closely match the Scrutineering Checklist used by Motorsport Australia Accredited Officials at event.
